

On-Site Learning Opportunities and Support Services

Pursuant to Executive Order 2020-51, the Academy of Tucson will offer online support services beginning August 17, 2020. We will start offering free on-site learning opportunities and support services for students "who are at-risk, in special education programs or who are the students of essential workers" and need a place to go during the school day.

Please note that a teacher **will not** lead the free on-site learning opportunities and support services classroom instruction. However, free on-site learning opportunities and support services will include in-person support services such as student supervision and strategic support for students in need during standard school hours.
